## PARASET POLYMERIC SAND

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This is a specially formulated mixture of ASTM C-144 graded sand and special additives to help sand stabilization for flexible and semi-rigid pavement systems using segmental pavers.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS:
$\diamond$ Just sweep into paver joints and spray with water.
PREPARATION:
$\diamond$ Place a base of sand using Paragon Pack Base Sand (follow bag instructions for installation).
$\diamond$ Place a bed of Paragon Paver Finish Sand to level pavers (follow bag instructions for installation).
$\diamond$ Use Paragon Paraset Polymeric Sand to lock down the pavers.

## PLACEMENT:

$\diamond$ Clean surface of all debris or other material.

- SURFACE MUST BE COMPLETELY DRY.
$\checkmark$ Pour Paraset Polymeric Sand in small piles about 12 inches apart on top of pavers. Sweep into and fill all points to bottom of the paver chamber.
$\diamond$ Avoid sweeping Paraset Polymeric Sand too far.
$\diamond$ Repeat as necessary to fill all joints.
$\diamond$ Compact all paver and joints with a tamp or vibrating plate.
$\diamond$ Fill and tamp or vibrate until all joints are filled.
$\diamond$ Using a fine broom and leaf blower, remove all excess material from surface. This is important to prevent surface staining.
$\diamond$ Set pavers and joints with a fine mist (avoid spraying into joints or flooding). Spray until there is a light water retention (approximately 2030 seconds.
$\diamond$ Repeat 2-3 times at 10 minute intervals to allow water penetration.
$\diamond$ Do not walk on for a minimum of 4 hours.
$\diamond$ Do not open to traffic for 24 hours.
$\diamond$ Do not use if rain is forecasted within 24 hours.
$\diamond$ Do not lay pavers when temperatures are below $40^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\left(4^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\right)$.
$\diamond$ This product is for locking down and securing pavers; it is not a mortar.
